Year 2 September - Year 2 December

<b>Objective:</b>	<p>To identify the existing materials on the selected thematic area. To analyse their relevance and appropriateness; and to start the preparation of the new materials. To prepare the materials ready for piloting. To define a concept of pedagogic interaction.</p> <p><i>What methods? Which approach? Which technology?</i></p>
<b>Activities</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Definition of content of the digital material in the decided frame<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the school teams decide the main substance / content area of their digital material</li></ul></li><li>2. Identification of existing materials on the selected content area<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Collecting interesting e-materials for presentation and assessment at the workshop (in Finland) by September 15</li></ul></li><li>3. Analysis of relevance of the existing materials<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- analysing the existing materials against the criteria produced during stage 1</li></ul></li><li>4. Creation of content units for the digital material<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- preparation of the main content units of the digital material</li></ul></li><li>5. Discussion and definition of pedagogic model to be applied<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- choosing the most suitable pedagogic model for the selected content of the digital material</li></ul></li><li>6. Definition of suitable technology to be used in the material production / delivery<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- based on the analysis of various technologies &amp; tools choosing the most suitable</li></ul></li><li>7. 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### VIRTUAL SEMINAR 2, October 24 – November 4, 2011

#### Objective:

The objective of Virtual seminar 2 is to present the status of the electronic learning material (ELM) production projects of the schools, part **Content Units** of Template 3.

The seminar will give the schools an opportunity to get feed-back on their design process and on how the main content areas of the ELM have been defined.

#### Implementation:

The Virtual seminar is understood as a joint working period on Moodle. It consists of school presentation (material to be up-loaded o Moodle), questions and feed-back from other schools and organised comments and proposals from the project expert team.

A separate Virtual seminar 2 space will be opened in Moodle for the ELM project teams to upload their work. There will be a space for general feedback open for everyone, too, in Moodle.

#### Process:

There is no one-fit-all format you should use here: be creative to get your message through.
2. Each pilot school will present comments & questions on the others material on Moodle	Mon 24.10.-Sun 30.10.2011	The material will be commented utilising the guiding questions under the assessment criteria purposeful, poly-cultural and practical.
3. Project experts will present comments & questions on the ELM project contents and participate in discussion.	Mon 24.10.-Sun 30.10.2011	The material will be commented utilising the guiding questions under the assessment criteria purposeful and poly-cultural.
4. On Moodle project experts will introduce the conclusions and recommendations based on the analysis of materials, feed-back given by schools.	Mon 31.10. – Fri 4.11.2011	Experts will give general feed-back on open space on Moodle and detailed feed-back to each ELM separately.
5. The virtual seminar will be closed.	Friday 4.11.2011	

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### VIRTUAL SEMINAR 3, February 7 – 17, 2012

#### Objective:

The objective of the virtual seminar is to present an ELM Pilot Implementation Plan (Template 4) on Moodle for the comments by other project pilot schools and the project experts.

#### Implementation:

The Virtual seminar is understood as a joint working period of school pairs facilitated by experts on Moodle. It consists of school presentations (uploaded Template 4 and pilot ELM unit) and comments received from pair schools and project experts.

A separated space for Virtual seminar 3 will be opened in Moodle for the school pairs to upload their Template 4 and pilot ELM unit and arrange discussion. The feed-back will be given by the pilot schools and project experts.

Based on the feed-back received the pilot schools will finalise the Pilot Implementation Plan (Template 4) and start the actual piloting based on the plan after the virtual seminar.

Project experts will present comments & questions on the ELM Pilot Implementation Plans and units and participate in discussion.	14.02.2012	The Finnish experts will comment the plan and pilot unit of the Finnish schools and the Russian experts will comment the plan and pilot unit of Russian schools. The material will be commented utilising the guiding questions attached to these instructions. The experts will summarise the general comments and share them on Moodle with everybody.
4. Based on the feed-back received the schools will finalise the EMM Pilot Implementation Plan	17.02.2012	The pilot schools will upload te final ELM Pilot Implementation Plan (Template 4) on Moodle.
