### Six P topics for discussion at Stage 3 end

#### **Participative**

#### **Pedagogical use of ICT**

- 1) How did you engage students to participate in the piloting phase?
  - Any changes in students' role and work?
  - Describe your collaborative practices.
- 2) How did your development team work during the piloting phase?
  - Describe your collaborative practices.
  - Did your development team structure change during the pilot process?

#### **Flexible pedagogical framework**

- 1) How did you encourage other teachers of your school to participate in the piloting phase?
  - Which working methods seemed to function best in your school?
  - What improved, or increased co-operation?
- 2) How did you inform the school and other teachers about the pilot use of DLM?
  - How do you plan to communicate your experiences from the pilot use of DLM?
- 3) How did you inform about it beyond your school?

#### **Making the T-S-L culture and process visible**

- 1) How do you collect comments and feedback from your development team, students, colleagues, parents, and your partner school?
  - How and where do you share the comments and feedback?
- 2) What did you learn during the process?
  - Which changes do you see in your work/T-S-L process/ students' work?
  - What was enjoyable about the pilot process?
  - What did not work?
  - Was the effort you put into the pilot worth it?
  - Share the lessons learned and exciting experiences with us.
- 3) What did the students comment on during the process?
  - What did your students value the most?
  - What got them excited?
  - What didn't your students like?
